- Each statement ends with a semicolon

OPERATIVE CLAUSE (TBIR)

- Require 1 TBIR statement
- May have up to 2 Further Therefore Be It Resolved Statements
- WHAT you want the organization to do

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Background information should include the history of the issue, potential impacts for the sponsoring municipality and the province-wide impacts for municipalities.

•Send Regional Resolutions for response & as information for ASB Provincial Committee

•Provincial Resolutions submitted to Secretary of ASB Provincial Committee

•ASB Provincial Committee

•ASB Provincial Committee meets to review Provincial Resolutions

•Amended resolutions submitted to Provincial Committee Secretary

•Amended resolutions submitted to Provincial Committee Secretary

•Resolutions & Report Card sent out

Late Resolutions



Late Resolutions Regional Meetings

- Regional Conferences
 - Not submitted to Regional Secretary 4 weeks prior to meeting
 - Must be accepted by simple majority by assembly
 - Sponsoring municipality must bring adequate copies for everyone to review
