

Stakeholder Resolutions

RMA & ASB's

Problem

- Neglect of weed control obligations on Oil & Gas Wellsites
- Weed notices are cost prohibitive, lack of debt recovery options
- Cost & liability now pushed to the Landowner

Proposed Actions

AER as Weed/Pest Inspectors

- REDA
 - WCA/APA to Specified Enactments
 - AER: Rule books/Manuals
- Inspector appointment under the WCA/APA would support REDA changes
- Goal: AER inspectors have jurisdiction on private land for Weeds & Pests

MGA & WCA/APA Alignment

- Investigating changes for MGA & WCA/APA
- AGI & MA are working collaboratively
- Goal: Wellsite maintenance debt to be applied to leaseholder taxes

Mature Asset Strategy Initiative

- Objective of MAS Find ways to manage aging oil & Gas infrastructure
- Meetings: Between September and December 2024
- <u>Participants</u>: Alberta Surface Rights Federation, Wheatland & Area Surface Rights, GoA Ministries, Oil & Gas Industry, RMA, LPRT.

MAS Participation – Positive Effects

- Increased awareness:
 - Weeds on wellsites issue
 - Weed/pest impact to Agricultural Trade
- Landowner participation highlighted the erosion of trust between oil and gas operators and rural communities.
- RMA participation highlighted the unpaid taxes by oil and gas operators
- Presentation to LPRT members on the impact of weeds/pests in Agriculture
- Opportunity to highlight the WG's endorsed actions
